

The Institute for Empirical Linguistics at the Faculty of Linguistics, Cultures and Arts of the **Goethe University in Frankfurt/Main, Germany** seeks to fill the following position as civil servant or public employee, funded by the LOEWE Programme of the Federal State of Hessen, to commence on 01.01.2020:

Professorship (W2) for Minority Languages in the Middle East

The appointment as Professor (civil servant or public employee) is for six years.

The professorship is responsible for the subproject "Kurds in Germany" as part of the LOEWE research cluster "Minority Studies: Language and Identity". The post holder has excellent knowledge of minority languages in the Middle East, especially Iranian languages in Iran and Turkey, and is identified through relevant preparatory work. A PhD in a relevant subject, additional scientific achievements as well as familiarity with methods of linguistic field research and language documentation are required. In addition, knowledge of third-party fund acquisition is expected. At the same time, the professorship is involved in teaching in the study programs Empirical Linguistics.

The designated salary for the position is based on "W2" of the German university scale or equivalent. The Goethe University aims to increase the proportion of women in research and teaching and urges qualified women scientists to apply. Applications of scientists from abroad are explicitly requested. Severely disabled applicants with equal qualification and aptitude will be given preferential consideration.
