

The Institute of Applied Linguistics, Translation and Interpreting at Universität des Saarlandes (Saarbrücken, Germany) offers **two research positions** (one full-time and one half-time) in the BMBF-funded project CLARIN-D (http://fr46.uni-saarland.de/index.php? id=3434); subject to approval.

CLARIN-D is a joint project of nine German research institutes and universities embedded in a larger European context. The goal is to build a research infrastructure for language resources and NLP tools, a virtual research environment, for the digital humanities.

A **full-time position** (Ref. W400) is open for a computer scientist or computational linguist with at least a master/diploma. Requirements are familiarity with repository systems, quality assessment (RAC or DSA), standards (ISO,W3C,TEI), Web 2.0, single identity and single sign-on operations, CMDI-specifications, OAI-PMH protocols.

Responsibilities include developing and maintaining a repository system as well as adapting, developing and extending language technology tools and resources.

The salary is according to the German TV-L system (level 13). The position is for three years with the possibility of extension (subject to follow-up funding). Starting date is July 1, 2011 or as soon as possible.

A **half-time position** (Ref. W401) is open for a Postdoc or PhD student. Prerequisites are a masters/ diploma degree or a PhD in computational linguistics. A strong background in corpusbased methods is required; experience in natural language processing methods, including statistical methods, is desirable. A good command of English is mandatory.

Responsibilities include developing curricula and training courses for NLP resources and tools as well as maintaining , extending and building resources.

The salary is according to the German TV-L system (level 13). The position is for two years with the possibility of extension (subject to follow-up funding). Starting date is July 1, 2011 or as soon as possible.
